TARA FESTIVAL CAMPING 2022



FESTIVAL CAMPING:

Onsite camping opens 8am Wednesday 27 July and closes Monday 1 August 2022.

The \$60 per site covers your total festival stay (it costs the same if you stay 1 or up to 5 nights).

Festival campsites are available only with the purchase of a 3-Day Festival Pass.

Up to 4 adults per camping site.

SIZE OF CAMPSITES:

The size of sites will vary a little in each zone. Expect to have similar space to the average caravan park site – large enough for a vehicle and caravan, or a vehicle and a tent for example. One vehicle per camping site (all additional vehicles to park in the festival carpark).

ALL CAMPERS MUST KEEP ALL ROPES, PEGS AND VEHICLES WITHIN THAT AREA.

ON ARRIVAL

Arrivals between 8am to 5 pm will be welcomed at the front gate, by our volunteers who will check you in, issue your festival wrist band which must be worn at all times whilst at the festival, and you will then be directed to your Camping Zone.

For safety and consideration of all campers we will NOT allow entry into the Campgrounds outside of the above-mentioned hours.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE IS STRICTLY NO ADMITTANCE INTO THE FESTIVAL GROUNDS (THE ENTERTAINMENT/RACETRACKSIDE AREAS) BEFORE 5pm FRIDAY.

CAMPING NEXT TO YOUR FRIENDS: GROUPS OF 5 OR LESS

If you are a group of 5 or less campsites who wish to camp together, ensure all individuals select the same camping ZONE when purchasing tickets and camping and arrive at the front entrance gate together, so that you all can be marshalled to your selected camp area together.

LARGER GROUP CAMPING (6 CAMPSITES OR MORE):

If you are a larger group that requires 6 or more campsites together you will need to email Sarah, Camping Coordinator via tarafestivalcamping@outlook.com

Please Include the following details:

- Group Name
- Contact Name
- Contact details (including phone & email)
- Number of sites required for your group
- Preferred Camp Zone (selected from the map below)

Doing so allows a group ticket and PROMO CODE to be created for your group. Once your group is registered, each member can book their tickets individually to be included in your large

group, ALL individuals in the group MUST have purchased their tickets and camping by <u>31 May 2022</u>. If any late comers wish to join your group, they can choose to book in the same camping 'zone' but we are unable to reserve them a spot immediately next to you.

AMENITIES

Toilet and shower facilities are in various convenient sites for festival campers in each zone.

POWER & GENERATORS

The sites at the festival are **not powered sites**. Generators are permitted from 8am to 7pm.

WATER

There are water taps located around the campgrounds, with potable water for festival campers. No hooking up is possible at the campgrounds.

DOGS.

Dogs are not permitted inside the festival or near the racetrack. Camels and Dogs don't mix.

We welcome dogs into the campgrounds, but they must be polite and **restrained at all times**. All dogs must be left at your campsite whilst you attend the festival.

CAMP FIRES

Campers are permitted to have a fire in a suitable above ground fire pit or bucket on their campsites ONLY.

NO FIRES ARE TO BE LIT ON THE GROUND.

ALL campers are to ensure that all coals, remaining half burnt wood, ash and debris is taken to the ash collection point at the campground entrance as you are leaving and there is to be no glass or tins in the fire debris.

Firewood and fire lighting kits will be available for purchase at the front entrance from Wednesday 27 July.

DUMP POINTS

There is one RV dump point at the Tara Lagoon Parklands, adjacent to the festival entry gate. Due to the large number of people utilising this dump point during the festival we suggest campers make use of a dump point before arriving in Tara.

RUBBISH

All rubbish is to be removed from the campgrounds; skip bins will be placed throughout the campgrounds for your convenience.

MONEY & BANKING

The Tara Post Office is a Commonwealth Bank agent and there are ATMs Facilities:

Tara Foodworks; Tara Café; Tara Commercial Hotel and inside the festival grounds Friday to Sunday.

FOOD VENDORS

All the food vendors inside the festival grounds will operate during festival hours. From 5pm Friday night and throughout the weekend. Alternatively, Tara Foodworks is well stocked and offers a wide variety of groceries, as well as Tara Bakery, Tara Café, Tara Commercial Hotel, and the Tara Bowls Club, will be able to provide meals and drinks throughout the week and weekend.

SHUTTLE BUS

A shuttle bus will be operating from the campgrounds to the main street. It's only a short walk from the Showgrounds to the main street, passing by our lovely lagoon.

PLEASE BEWARE & STOP

Previous festivals we have unfortunately had visitors booked by police for not stopping at the Railway Crossing as they entered Tara. Please keep an eye out for the **STOP sign** and stop fully.
