## GLAMPING DATES:

2 Nights Glamping Accommodation

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> July and Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

## ARRIVAL:

Check in from 10am Friday 29<sup>th</sup> July

- Please arrive before 5 pm to be welcomed at the front gate by our volunteers who will scan your glamping tickets, issue your festival wrist band and you will then be directed to the glamping area.
- Prior to arrival you will be given a tent number and a code that will unlock the combination lock on your tent.

## DEPARTURE:

We have a late check out available for glampers. Check out of your tent by 4pm Sunday after all the festival events have finished. Tents are not available Sunday night.

- linen
- doona
- blankets

- cushions

- LED lantern
- floor mats

A communal glamping marquee will have tables and chairs.

## WHAT **IS NOT** INCLUDED IN YOUR TENT:

- Towels (please BYO towels, toiletries, and washers)
- Tents do not have power points in them. Power will be available nearby in the glamping communal tent; however, you may also need to rely on your own portable charger.

## FOOD VENDORS

- All the food vendors inside the festival grounds will operate during festival hours, From 5pm Friday night and throughout the weekend. Alternatively, Tara Food works is well stocked and offers a wide variety of groceries, as well as Tara Bakery, Tara Café, Tara Commercial Hotel, and the Tara Bowls Club, will be able to provide meals and drinks throughout the week and weekend.

## WATER

There are water taps located around the festival campgrounds with potable water in various locations.

A shuttle bus will be operating from the festival to the main street. It's only a short walk from the festival to the main street, passing by our lovely lagoon.
